The City of Trees

The city of Manchester in England has embarked on an ambitious plan to plant three million trees. The project is called the "City of Trees". Project director, Tony Hothersall, explained that the green venture had three main aims. He said: "One is to plant three million trees - a tree for every man, woman and child -over the next 25 years. Next, we are very much focused on bringing existing woodland into management because there is no point in planting new woodland if you can't manage what you've got already. Finally, we want to engage people a lot more in their natural environment - in planting trees, in managing areas, [and] in understanding more about the benefits that trees and woodlands bring to our society."



Mr Hothersall further outlined the rationale behind the recently-launched environmental project. He said: "Manchester wants to be a world-class city region. We have a lot of fantastic development going on, but the natural environment needs to keep up with that." He believes the initiative will reconnect people with trees and the natural world, provide benefits to health and reduce stress. He said: "Woodlands can do great things in terms of air pollution reduction and can help to screen for noise pollution. They can also help cities and towns become more resilient to climate change both in terms of things like reducing the urban heat Island effect and also reducing flooding."

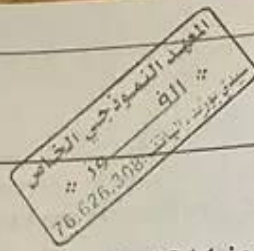

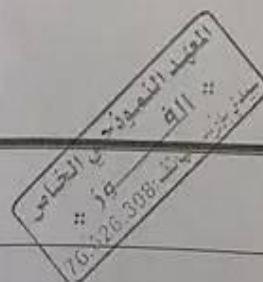

(1) The Titanic was built in 1911 in Belfast, Northern Ireland. The ship was enormous - 882 feet long (approximately the length of three football fields) and 92.5 feet wide - and it was equipped with some of the most modern safety features of the age. In fact, The Titanic was thought that it was unsinkable. On her first journey, in April 1912, all the passengers were taken on at Southampton (England), Cherbourg (France) and Cork (Ireland). Life in the first class was luxurious: evenings were spent in the restaurants or listening to concerts.

(2) At 10 pm on Sunday 14th April, the Titanic was warned about icebergs in the area. But the Titanic continued to travel at high speed and an iceberg was hit at 11.45pm. Many passengers were woken by the shock. All crew was called onto the deck. The ship had 16 boats for only 1,200 people, instead of the 64 lifeboats of the original design. The lifeboats were put into the sea but many of them weren't filled. Many people still felt safer on board the Titanic!

(3) The band on board played music until the boat sank at 2:20 am on 15th April with 2,222 people on board. SOS signals were sent by The Titanic. Five other ships received these signals. A ship called The Carpathia rescued a few people. They were given hot drinks and dry clothes by the crew. 1522 people lost their lives. The Titanic dropped 2,5 miles to the ocean floor. Only 705 people survived.
