Come Run With Me



Lifeguard Simon Lewis usually spends his summers assisting the carefree, sun-bathed tourists on the local beach. But this year, the club director spent the first week of January pulling refugees from the cold wild waves off the coast of the Greek island of Lesbos.

During their ten - day mission as part of the International Surf Lifesaving Association and Greece's Lifeguard Hellas, Simon and the team were able to save 517 refugees from drowning. He was determined to join the mission after seeing images of the Syrian kid, Aylan Kurdi. "I was sitting on my couch thinking- I'm a lifeguard, and all these people are drowning. Why am I not there helping save their lives?" Eventually, Simon set up a crowd funding to cover the basic needs for his trip and sent it to family and friends. The news soon spread. His phone started ringing and the community donated £30,000 in one day. It was a special moment that proved that Simon had made the right decision.

The money he raised was able to fund life-saving rescue equipment for the Lesbos patrol together with other devices that can keep hundreds of people afloat when a boat sinks. The success of the fundraiser and what it achieved put Simon at it again. This time, he is using his passion for long- distance running to gain more support for the cause.

Having seen on the ground where the donations go, and those blankets distributed to refugees and watching them warm up_ made him realize that donations really make a difference. Simon hopes to inspire others to do their part to fundraise for the vital efforts on Lesbos. "I'm just a normal guy who has the opportunity to experience this and make a difference." He concluded.

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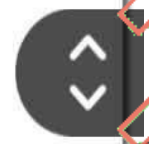
